Dear resident

Thank you to everyone who has been in touch with my campaign on the issue of the Green Belt.

In Wirral, the Green Belt has been at risk for almost 20 years due to the Labour Council's failure to adopt a legally required 'Local Plan' to protect it. It is only since Labour lost control of Wirral Council in 2019 that there has been real progress.

However, the Council's new draft Local Plan, which will protect Wirral's Green Belt, is not yet in force. It will fall to the next Government to either allow the plan to go ahead or, potentially, tell Wirral to rip it up and start again.

My concern is that, if Labour wins on Thursday 4th July, they will follow through on their stated aim to overrule local communities and encourage developers to build on the Green Belt.

Thanks to the work of our local councillors in Moreton and Saughall Massie, we know that three developers have already submitted counter proposals to the Local Plan. This would see 1,000 houses built on Green Belt around Saughall Massie.

The Conservative Manifesto makes clear our position.

We will retain our cast-iron commitment to protect the Green Belt from uncontrolled development, while ensuring more homes get built where it makes sense, such as the urban areas in Wirral.

Our current national planning protections mean there is never any top-down requirement for councils to remove Green Belt protection. With a Conservative Government, these will remain in place.
